Publications recognize Grand Valley companies

ColoradoBiz Magazine announced the winners of Top Company Awards in 10 industry categories at a luncheon in Denver. A panel of Colorado business leaders, including co-sponsor Deloitte, judged entrants based on such criteria as financial performance and community involvement as well as innovation in marketing and product development.

Rocky Mountain Health Plans won in the health care category. Last year, the not-for-profit health plan launched a new suite of individual plans called SOLO designed to provide comprehensive, affordable health coverage for many of Colorado's uninsured. Rocky Mountain Health Plans also contributed a total of \$728,000 to more than 70 community based organizations around the state in 2006.

JG Management Systems — a consulting firm that provides a range of services, mostly to government agencies — won in the small business category of the Colorado's Best Companies for Working Families program conducted by *Colorado Parent magazine*.

JGMS offers a fully paid benefits package that includes medical, dental, disability and life insurance. Employees also receive vacation and personal time off as well as considerable flexibility in scheduling.

JGMS also was included in the 2007 *Inc. magazine* listing of the 500 fastest-growing privately held companies in the United States and ranks 25th in a listing of the top 50 minority owned businesses in Colorado compiled by *ColoradoBiz Magazine*.
